

ACE57110P 1A Bipolar Linear Regulator

Description

ACE57110P is a series of low dropout three-terminal regulators with a dropout of 1.3V at 1A load current. ACE57110P features a very low standby current 2mA compared to 5mA of competitor.

Other than a fixed version, Vout = 1.2V, 1.5V, 1.8V, 2.5V, 2.85V, 3.3V and 5V, ACE57110P has an adjustable version, which can provide an output voltage from 1.25 to 12V with only two external resistors. ACE57110P offers thermal shut down function, to assure the stability of chip and power system. And it uses trimming technique to guarantee output voltage accuracy within 2%.

ACE57110P is available in SOT89-3 package.
